During the EuroSportFestival 2005 in Clermont-Ferrand, we were approached by an overwhelming number of participants who asked for shooting (air pistol and air rifle) on our 2007 sports programme. Naturally, we want to be able to welcome as many participants as possible to the games in 2007, so we have asked the EFCS to grant us permission to add shooting to our already existing sports programme.

So in 2007, we will be able to offer you no less than 21 sports disciplines:

- Badminton
- Basketball
- Bowling
- Bridge
- Chess
- Darts (not electronics)
- Golf
- Handball indoor
- Miniature golf
- Orienteering race
- Petanque
- Football (11 players)
- Football (7 players)
- Football (5 players)
- Shooting
- Squash
- Swimming
- Table tennis
- Track and field
- Outdoor tennis
- Volleyball

● Golf

Golf has always been a popular sport with many participants at the European Company Sports Games. Therefore, the organisers of the games in 2007 have decided to divide golf players into the following categories, as previous experience from Clermont-Ferrand indicates that this will optimise the tournament and the experience of the participants.

- A: Handicap 0 – 14.9
- B: Handicap 15.0 – 24.9
- C: Handicap 25.0 - 36.0
- D: Handicap 37 – 54

All categories will play stableford as advised in the Sports Management manual.

● Age divisions

In order to make the best possible preparations of the European Company Sports Games in Aalborg in 2007, we have put together a team consisting of representatives from all the sports disciplines on the programme in 2007. This team will review the tournament programme also in relation to the possibility of new age divisions, which will ensure more even matches.
